Daily Sign In/Out

All campers must be signed in and out at the beginning and end of each day. They will not be released to anyone who has not been listed on the emergency pickup form. If the person picking up the student is unrecognized by the staff, they will be asked to show identification. Both parents' names should be included on the emergency form. If the other parent is NOT allowed to pick up your child, please indicate that on the form.

Tuition

Camp Books

Each camper will receive a “camp book” on their first day at camp, which contains important information for both musical theatre and film/video majors. Campers are allowed to write in and keep their own book.

Film/Video Majors

Students participating in this major are welcome to bring their own video cameras to camp. However, it is not required. If they do not own their own camera, they will have access to a professional camera owned by Artios Academies, as well as a green screen and film lighting. On the first day of camp, campers will also be informed of anything they might need to bring from home. At the end of the week, all film majors will present their short film at the Outpost showcase!

Musical Theatre Majors

Auditions

On the first day of camp, students participating in this major will audition for a singing, dancing, and/or speaking role and are allowed to verbally specify in which areas they are most interested at the time of their audition. Each student should come prepared to perform a song no longer than one minute, sung with an accompaniment track on a CD or sung a cappella. All students are encouraged to incorporate some acting and/or choreography into their audition. If a student comes unprepared with their own song, they will have the option of singing “Happy Birthday.” If this is your student’s first time auditioning, they will have the option of either auditioning in front of the group or for the staff privately. At Outpost, we do our best to support and encourage each student through this process and do not promote a competitive nature amongst the students. General Musical Theatre Info

- Closed-toed shoes are required at all times, as all students will be participating in some choreography during their elective times.
- Scripts and CD’s will be sent home on the first day of camp. CD’s **must** be returned on Friday, before the showcase. **A \$10 fee will be charged for CD’s not turned in.**

Showcase Costumes

Artios Outpost provides some costume pieces and props. However, students are asked to put together their costumes at home based on the information provided on the costume sheet in their camp books. All costume pieces should be brought to camp on **Thursday** morning in a labeled paper or plastic bag.

Showcase Info

The Outpost Showcase will be held on Friday (the last day of camp), at **3:30pm**. The show is open to the community so please feel free to invite friends and family!

Outpost Camper Talent Show

The Outpost Talent Show is open to any camper who would like to participate. The show will be Thursday afternoon during the week of camp. If your student would like to participate, please have them sign up at the registration table by Wednesday. **Their “act” will need to be approved by the directors by 3:30pm on Wednesday.** Please use Christian or Musical Theatre related music keep all performances (including language, movement, music, and lyrics) completely appropriate and “kid-friendly.”

General Behavior and Dress Code

The Artios Outpost is an unapologetically Christian and Biblical program. With that in mind, students should conduct themselves as Scripture calls them to. The Artios Outpost uses Philippians 4:8 as a general rule:

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

It is our hope and prayer that all students will conduct themselves in a manner consistent with this verse. As a result of that verse, we ask the following:

- Students should not use any speech that is unbecoming of Christian men and women which includes all forms of cursing, crude, or lewd jokes/speech, etc.
- Students are to treat each other, staff, and camp directors with respect and are asked to exemplify a Christ-like character in every situation.
- Students should dress modestly and appropriately for a variety of activities
 - No private body parts should be seen from any angle at any time

- No midriff showing
- Shorts should not be shorter than the student's fingertips
- Tank tops should be at least 3 fingers wide
- No articles of clothing should be worn with crude language, jokes, or words
- **Girls should not wear skirts** and/or sheer or see through articles of clothing (all students will be extremely active during camp)

Discipline Policy

Our staff at the Artios Outpost is committed to maintaining a **fun, uplifting, and safe environment** for each student attending. With that in mind, our discipline policy is as follows:

If a correction is given to a student and not followed, he/she will be pulled aside from that activity and be talked to by one of our staff members. If the behavior continues, that student will be asked to sit out of that activity. After a third correction is given, a parent will be notified and asked to pick up their student for the rest of the day. For recurring behavior, a student may be asked to leave the Outpost permanently.
